Grant Application Procedure

Thank you for your interest in Blue Horse Charities. Blue Horse Charities was formed in 2001 to assist organizations that provide Thoroughbred racehorse retraining and adoption. Blue Horse is financed in equal parts by buyers, consignors and Fasig-Tipton. Applications for grants will be accredited by Thoroughbred Charities of America (TCA), the managing agent for Blue Horse Charities and the charitable arm of the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association (TOBA).

Grants applications for 2010 funding will be accepted January 1, 2010 through April 1, 2010. Grant applications must be postmarked by April 1, 2010.

To apply for a grant with Blue Horse Charities please submit the following:

- 1-Completed grant application
- 2-2009 adoption record
- 3-Copy of your organizations 501 (c) (3) status
- 4-Your adoption application and adoption policies
- 5-Any additional information (brochures, informational sheets) about your organization

All applications will be reviewed and considered at our Board of Directors meeting in May/June of each year. For all approved applications, grants will be processed shortly thereafter, and distributed in June 2010.
